The printed edition consists of 22 volumes containing the transcription of approximately 20 000 diplomas connected to Norway in the period 1050 to 1590. Vol. I-XXI contain the text of 15 995 diplomas. The transcriptions were done from 1840 to 1972. Expanded abbreviation are not marked in volumes I-XX and the original hyphenation is ignored. Errors introduced by the type setters are not infrequent. Thus the texts should be used with caution.
