Reading journal articles, composing glossaries on self-chosen articles, presenting and discussing them; preparing a questionnaire in your own field and an accompanying cover letter; academic writing with a special focus on short text types in the field of Health Sciences (summary/ abstract, bio, cover letter, questionnaire, survey);

presentation skills and giving a field-related presentation. During the course, you will develop your speaking skills necessary in professional conversations, job interviews, meetings and/or conferences, etc.

Contact teaching and tutorials (24 hrs), completion of home assignments: journals, glossaries, questionnaire and cover letter (20 hrs), presentation of self-selected literature (16 hrs) and writing tasks (20 hrs). Some course work can be completed online.

The ultimate aim is to help you gain the skills to read and write academic / scientific text and to discuss related topics. To help you achieve the learning outcomes, you will work on many varied written and oral activities which focus primarily on practicing vocabulary learning strategies, word formation, and the use of the most frequent academic vocabulary (AWL sublists).

**Sisältö:**

This course has a focus on verbal skills and the vocabulary of various business-related topics including meetings and negotiations and the start-up business sector. Active participation is mandatory. The course includes 18 classroom sessions and the sessions are held twice a week. Each classroom session is followed by homework which must be completed before the next session. The course includes three entrepreneurial mindset workshops. The homework lessons will include vocabulary exercises, grammar and preparation for various tasks including the compilation of either a business plan or a business model canvas which will be the basis of a presentation. The course also includes study group work. The course has an attendance policy due to the verbal nature of the course. You can miss two sessions if necessary. Any further absences will affect your grade and possibly cause you to fail the course. The course is connected to the BizWiz Pitching event. Participation in the Pitching event is voluntary and space is limited. Candidates for pitching at the event are selected by students in the classroom.

If you received a Laudatur or Eximia in English on your Matriculation examination, you are able to complete only Module 1 or Module 2 of the Business Writing course. Be aware that you are also allowed to complete the entire Business Writing course and you can use your L or E to replace either Module 1 OR Module 2 of the Integrated Text and Business Studies course. Make your decision based on which skills you need to develop the most. There is no separate registration for only module 1 or 2. You simply register in weboodi for the 4-credit course even if you plan to complete only Module 1 or 2. When you register for your course in weboodi, inform the teacher immediately if you have credit transfers.

- write business proposals, reports, and press releases with a good degree of fluency using the essential components of each in a professional business register

**Sisältö:**

This is a writing course which consists of two modules. Module one is a self-study course. In module one of the course students will meet in the classroom for three sessions and will participate in four follow-up tutoring sessions. Following the classroom sessions students will study the instructions and examples of various business documents and write their own business documents, for example a letter of enquiry, letter of response and letter of introduction. During this part of the course the student will focus on writing fluency, appropriate professional tone as well as special vocabulary specific to written business communication. Students will complete the assignments, and meet with the instructor in private tutorial sessions to get feedback on their own writing skills. This process will be repeated four times before beginning of the second part of the course. All homework should be written as though the student is employed by a company and the visual appeal should be at such a level that any organization in the business world would approve.

In module two of the course, the focus is on improving grammatical proficiency at higher levels of English. All grammatical exercises are designed to bring the writer closer towards or into the C1 level. This is followed by a review of effective and fluent written communication including writing proposals, reports and press releases. Attention will be paid to professional writing style and tone, writing positive messages and understanding the

difference between informal and formal English. Special attention should be used on the delivery of written communication, on the visual appeal of the documents. All homework should be written as though the student is

Changes in literature requirements are possible if the faculty changes reading requirements. Books are chosen which are required reading in subject courses in Oulu Business School and they will be used in this course along with other texts. Students will practice strategies for reading academic texts, for note-taking, for summarizing, and students will gain practice in preparing and presenting presentations. There is a strong emphasis on field-related vocabulary development. Students will work in study groups in addition to attending classroom sessions.

**Module 2**

Business Studies is an intensive study group and self-study course which consists of nine lessons. The course includes five mandatory classroom sessions and two quiz sessions as well. Each lesson is designed to take about four hours of time. Students should carefully read the materials, complete exercises, watch videos and focus on learning a lot of new vocabulary. In Module 2 there will be two vocabulary and concept quizzes to measure how well information has been understood and internalized. Each quiz should be successfully completed before students move on to the next lesson package. Business Studies is designed according to the following learning objectives: The student can demonstrate the ability to read, interpret and understand field-related texts at a satisfactory level of understanding. The student will expand his or her professional and business-related vocabulary. - osoittamaan kykenevänsä kommunikoidaan tehokkaasti potilaiden kanssa (potilaskeskeinen haastattelu), keskustelemaan tapauksista kollegojen kanssa ja raporttoimaan niistä lääketieteen ammattilaisille englanniksi (Moduuli 2);
- keskustelemaan mielenkiintoisista kliinisen psykologian aiheista ja esittelemään niitä (Moduuli 3);
- keskustelemaan tieteellisen viestinnän ja yleisten lääketieteellisten käytänteiden mukaisesti (Moduuli 2);

**Sisältö:**

Kurssi koostuu kolmesta moduulista.

Moduuli 1 on integroitu anatomian ja solubiologian kurssiin. Opiskelijat oppivat tieteellisissä raporteissa käytettävän kielen rakenteita, sääntöjä ja käytänteitä. Tämä moduuli järjestetään ensimmäisen vuoden syyslukukaudella periodilla I.

Moduuli 2 keskittyy lääketieteelliseen terminologiaan ja anatomiaan. Opiskelijat oppivat lääketieteellisen terminologian perusteet ja kehittävät omia strategioitaan hallitakseen kehon elinjärjestelmiin ja niiden toimintoihin liittyviä englanninkielisiä lääketieteellisiä termejä. Opiskelijat lukevat tapausselostuksia ja oppivat tehokasta lääkäri-potilas- ja lääkäri-lääkäri-kommunikaatiota. Tämä moduuli järjestetään 1. lukuvuoden periodeilla II-III.

Moduuli 3 on integroitu kliinisen psykologian kurssiin. Opiskelijat raportoivat kliinisen psykologian kurssilla tutkituista mielenkiintoista aiheista ja keskustelevat niistä. Tätä varten he työskentelevät tiimeissä ja laativat englanninkielisen tieteellisen yhteenvedon (Moduuli 1) ja posterin, jonka he esittelevät minikonferenssissa kevätlukukauden lopussa (Moduuli 3).
