The East and Southeast Asian Studies programme offers an opportunity to study the region from the perspectives of culture, history, economy and business as well as political and societal research.

The East and Southeast Asian Studies programme is co-ordinated by the Department of History. University Lecturer of East Asian History Seija Jalagin is responsible for registering study credits. Exam results are announced via the Network's website (www.asianet.fi). Study transcripts can be obtained from the Lecturer of East Asian Studies (Department of History, HU 356). A curriculum of the offered courses is published annually by the Network for Asian Studies.

Study packages and learning outcomes

Students are free to compile a Basic Level Study package from the courses offered. Upon completion of the East and Southeast Asian Studies programme, students will have acquired the necessary skills to work in positions related to their major subject, that require an understanding of East and Southeast Asian and South Asian cultures.

Upon completion of the Basic Level Studies, students will be familiar with the basics of East and Southeast Asian as well as South Asian cultures from the perspectives of history, contemporary society, economy and cultural interaction. Students will also have acquired skills necessary for pursuing further studies in the discipline.
