Ancient Languages and Culture

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Overview of the subject

Both lines of the subject (Latin Language and Roman literature, Greek language and literature) can be studied only as minor subjects. Students can choose one or both of the lines. The subject focuses on the Greek and Roman culture of the Mediterranean area, utilizing original sources written in Greek and Latin. The historically oriented language subject aims to familiarize students with ancient Greco-Roman culture and its effects on the cultures and languages of our time, through the Middle Ages, the Renaissance and the Enlightenment.

The subject is a good minor subject choice especially for students of History or Archaeology, but also for students of language, art and culture subjects, and to others as well, because of its all-round educative nature.

Admission requirements and commencement of studies

Ancient Languages and Culture is an open subject for all attending students of the University of Oulu. Sufficient skills in Latin or Greek are a prerequisite to beginning the studies. For students who have not acquired these skills in pre-university education, for instance, the subject arranges basic- and intermediate-level courses in both languages. A basic course in Latin is sometimes also arranged at the Summer University. Languages that are useful as regards studying the subject include English, Swedish, German, French and Italian. Since only a small amount of contact teaching is available, it is required that the student be willing and able to work independently. Guidance and examinations are available on request also in English, Italian, Swedish, German, Spanish and Latin.

Learning objectives at different levels

Latin language and Roman literature

The objective of the Basic Studies (25 credits) is to familiarize students with the main features of the culture of ancient Rome, and to provide them with language skills which will enable them to understand relatively easy Latin prose independently, with the help of references. The objective of the Intermediate Studies (35 credits) is to deepen and broaden the students' skills in the Latin language and knowledge of Latin literature, as well as to broaden their view of the entire history of the Antiquity and to instruct them in the use of varied source materials.

Greek language and literature

The objective of the Basic Studies (25 credits) is to familiarize students with the main features of the culture of ancient Greece, and to provide them with language skills which will enable them to understand relatively easy Greek prose independently, with the help of references. The objective of the Intermediate Studies (35 credits) is to deepen and broaden the students' skills in the Greek language and knowledge of Greek literature, as well as to broaden their view of the entire history of the Antiquity and to instruct them in the use of varied source materials.

Employment prospects

The subject provides an opportunity to acquire the qualifications required for a teacher of Latin language. In addition, the subject will be useful for students planning to become researchers or teachers, and for students aiming at other posts requiring humanistic education (e.g. in the fields of new languages, history, art history and literature, library and museum institutions, culture and information)

Practical information

Besides contact teaching, the student will have to take a large number of examinations independently. Examinations can be taken on the examination days of History Sciences and of the Faculty, and students should register for them in WebOodi no later than 10 days prior to the examination day. It is recommendable that students agree upon the examination contents with the Lecturer beforehand.

As regards ancient nomenclature and terminology, the recommended resource is P. Castrén - L. Pietilä-Castrén, *Antiikin käsikirja*.

The teacher responsible for all of the study packages is Timo Sironen, Lecturer of Ancient Languages and Culture.

Upon completion of the course, the student will be familiar with Latin grammar and essential vocabulary to such a degree that he/she will be able to interpret even more demanding Latin language sources.

To be chosen with the examiner from the following, or other literature: Prose: a speech by Cicero, Caesar, *De bello Gallico* (c. 1 book), Sallust, *Coniuratio Catilinae*, Livy, *Ab urbe condita* (selection), Tacitus, *Germania*.

Poetry: Catullus, selection, Horace, Odes or *Ars poetica*, Virgil, *Aeneis* (1 book) or *Eclogae* (selection), Ovid, *Metamorphoses* (selection) or *Ars Amand*, The Oxford Book of Medieval Latin Poetry (selection). The selection of inscriptions can be agreed upon with the examiner.
