What is mentoring?

Mentoring aims at supporting you in career planning and management as well as realizing your potential. You will be matched with a mentor to discuss any career or study related issues you find important or that worry you. You will set targets for the mentoring programme as well as for each meeting. You will be in charge of planning an agenda for each mentor-mentee meeting. Your mentor will have at least five years of job experience. Mentors are often University of Oulu alumni.

Who can apply?

All Master's degree students can apply. Applicants must be interested in career management, motivated to self-development and ready to commit to the mentoring relationship. The number of participants may need to be restricted.

When?

The mentoring programme starts in October-November and ends in April-May. During the programme, the university will organise three meetings for all mentors and mentees. The mentor and mentee agree on private meetings, usually 3-8 during the programme.

Application

Interview

Applicants will be interviewed in groups on Thursday, September 22, between 8-16 (Tellus conference rooms). Please save the date. Applicants will receive an invitation with an exact time and location for the interview after application dead line.

Selection

Student selection is made by Alumni Relations, Tellus team and Faculties/degree programmes. OBS students are selected by their own faculty. Selection criteria: are study year, motivation and finding a suitable mentor. Selection is announced to all applicants on October 10.
