- be a doctoral student in the Health and Biosciences Doctoral Programme (HBS-DP)
- submit a short abstract for presentation (oral or poster) by the deadline

In the abstract, include the title of your presentation, your contact details (name, Faculty, research group, email address, student number), and indicate your preference for an oral or poster presentation. The Organizing Team will select the speakers based on the received abstracts. You will be informed about acceptance no later than one week after the abstract submission deadline.
